

New Directions Pharmacy Registration Process

New Directions Pharmacy candidates can register via the company website. The Pharmacy team and the in house Compliance team check all online applications on a 24 hour basis. If the registration is completed fully, then candidates are entered onto our database. If the registration is incomplete, then candidates details are saved into a folder to be re-submitted.
